It also advised two insurers on recovery actions against urban highway concessionaire Costanera Norte, its contractor Sacyr, and the Chilean Ministry of Public Works, regarding losses (affecting dozens of office and residential buildings in Santiago) caused by flooding following the diversion of the Mapocho River during construction works.
